Project Location: The proposed project involves resumption of freight rail service on a section of existing rail line which extends approximately 142 miles from Willits in Mendocino County, California southward to Lombard in Napa County. From Willits the line runs southward generally following Highway 101 through Redwood Valley, Calpella, Ukiah, Hopland, Cloverdale, Geyserville, Healdsburg, Windsor, Santa Rosa, Rohnert Park, Cotati, Petaluma, and Novato. South of Novato, at Highway 37, the line runs eastward near the shore of San Pablo Bay, over the Petaluma River, past Black Point, past the old station at Schellville, over the Napa River, and

terminates in Lombard north of the city of American Canyon. At Lombard, the rail line joins the national rail system.
