Hi Hiedy,

It is a fairly straightforward request from a community 501 (c)(3) Interested in cleaning up transient encampments and drug-dealing accessed by the NCRA R.O.W. on the north end of Fortuna.

The specifics:

The Riverlife Foundation is requesting permission to erect barricades at the NCRA property (or R.O.W.) at 3rd and Main Streets (behind Ready Rents) in Fortuna. The proposal is to place concrete blocks perpendicular to the either side of the tracks and another that would run parallel between the tracks and resting on the ties.

This is a somewhat urgent matter as the Sheriff's SWAP team will be cleaning out the area in question on Friday and the hope is to get the blockade in place before trespassers make their way back (as they are wont to do).

If we can't get it on the agenda I will bring it up under matters from the Board.
